## NESHONOC STOCKED WITH MORE FINGERLINGS!

The stocking wasn't promised because of the VHS virus, but the DNR, and Jordan Weeks, came up big for us this last Thursday, as we assisted them in putting 426 fingerlings into Lake Neshonoc.

Understanding that the stocking would be on short notice, Jordan let us know a day in advance of the time, and that we would be needed to also assist in the fin clipping and tagging of the released fish.

At 11:00 AM

Thursday, the 14th, the fish showed at the Swarthout Park launch. Our group of the Darneal's, Kathy Kelemen, Julie Cornish, and Tim Wells aided the DNR in the stocking.

The fish stocked ranged from 12 -15.5" inches and of the 426 stocked, 100 were tagged. All of the fish were fin clipped.

Special thanks to the helpers and especially to the Darneal's, and Julie Cornish, who got some excellent photos of the days events.

I'll try to get some of the photos onto the website.

It's good to see that the stocking of this lake is moving forward even though we're dealing with some financial, and biological, setbacks.

Kudos to Jordan, and our Wisconsin local DNR, for continuing to work through these difficult times.

We'll continue to work with the DNR and provide them the man power and financial support they need to make Neshonoc a quality muskie fishery!

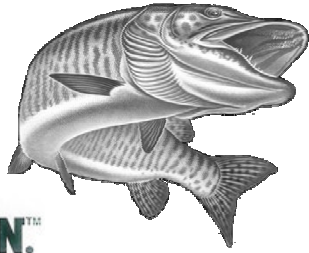

Roughly 21-24 attended our September Steve Wiltinger Memorial outing on Lake Holcombe. This was our last outing of the year for 2010, and proved to be a good action packed weekend.

Any lake was available for fishing as long as the members attended the Saturday social dinner held at the Pine Point Campground.

This year's winner of the Steve Wiltinger Memorial traveling trophy was Brad Foss, as he boated a 45" and 38" on the Dairyland Reservoir on Friday.

Friday turned out to be a great day on Holcombe also, as Steve's brother, Jim, boated a 39", 34", and 30" along with a 42" that was caught outside of the contest hours.

New member Mark Buel, caught a 35" and 30" to round out the Friday catches.

Saturday turned out to be just as good of a day, as 4 more fish were caught with 3 of those being larger than 42".

Jim Mazzone boated a 44", Prairie Bob a 42", and Jim Wiltinger a short 29". The largest fish of the weekend went to Corey Pettis with a nice 51". He also again won the largest Northern contest with a 32.5" winning \$80 for his efforts.

Special mention goes out to new member Matt Kelemen, as he boated the only Sunday fish although it was after the contest fishing hours. He ended up boating a 44" that had to be pushing close to 30 pounds. A very nice fish!

Jim reported that it was a very good outing, and congrats to those that caught fish. If you didn't, hopefully you had a great time and learned more about this crazy sport!
